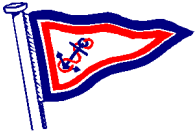

FULL MEMBERSHIP

Full Membership of the Civil Service Sailing Association is open to anyone eligible for membership of the Civil Service Sports Council (Sports and Leisure). In addition to employees of the Civil Service, BT and the Post Office, this includes the staff of over one hundred other bodies such as English Heritage and the Research Councils, members of HM armed forces, the police, local authorities and National Health employees. Full Membership is also open to former members of CSSC who have left government service, or those who have retired and are still receiving a pension from an eligible organisation. If in doubt about your eligibility, please contact the CSSC Membership Department on 01494 888444.

If you can quote your CSSC membership number, simply complete and return the form overleaf for Full Membership of the CSSA and you will receive your card. Otherwise please complete and return an application for CSSC Sports and Leisure Membership together with the form overleaf. For 2012 CSSC Membership is £3.60 per month or £43.20 per annum for those still in employment, reduced to £3.24 or £38.88 for qualifying members on pension or linked members over 65 years of age. On return of this form you are a member of CSSA and should receive a membership card and start receiving "CS Sailing" magazine, subject to confirmation of your acceptance for CSSC Membership.

The CSSA has several constituent Clubs and Divisions around the country for dinghy and yacht sailing, as described in separate leaflets. CSSA members are eligible to join these clubs but may have to pay an additional annual subscription to the Club or Division for use of local facilities. The CSSA operates three yachts for its members, all with a crewing bureau. Please indicate your clubs of interest overleaf. All of the facilities and events of the CSSA are developed, run and maintained by volunteers, so many of the amateur and professional skills of its members are very welcome. Please mention any such skills, knowledge or experience on the form overleaf.

E CSSC LINKED MEMBERSHIP

Also available for non-Qualifying Members is Linked Membership of CSSC, sponsored by one existing member of CSSC, payable by cheque or Direct Debit at the same rates as a normal full member of CSSC. This is available using the same CSSC joining forms from the membership sections of either www.cs-sailing.org or www.cssc.co.uk.

All potential CSSA members can first use a limited temporary membership to sail, meet other members and obtain the necessary sponsorship, or can sail on club yachts for one trip of up to 14 days in just one 12 month period only.
